Requirement for Dairy, Beef, Feeder Calf, Sheep, Goats, Horses and Swine

All Cattle, Goats, Cervids, Sheep, and Swine must have an official USDA Identification Tag. All animals on exhibition regardless of age, must meet MDARD Rules. Health Requirements for Livestock Exhibited in Michigan may be viewed on the Michigan Department of Agriculture and Rural Development website at

Any animals failing to meet these requirements will not be allowed to remain on the premises.

- 2. Entries limited to space available
- 3. All cattle must be bona fide property of the exhibitor at the time of entry.
- 4. Exhibits must be in place by Monday at 7:00 p.m.
- 5. All animals must remain until Sunday at 9:00 p.m.
- 6. Entry fee \$5.00 per head, paid in the fair office at time of arrival.
- 7. Animals cannot be sold at the auction.
- 8. Registration papers must be presented for breed classes.
- 9. Entries close August 10th. Entries should be mailed to Saline Community Fair, P O Box 423, Saline, MI 48176.
