All Cattle, Goats, Cervids, Sheep, and Swine must have an official USDA Identification Tag. All animals on exhibition regardless of age, must meet MDARD Rules. Any animals failing to meet these requirements will not be allowed to remain on the premises.

- 2. Lambs in this class cannot show in Department 6 Saline Lamb Club or Open Market Lambs.
- 3. Lambs must be in place by 6:00 p.m. Tuesday.
- 4. Owners must arrange for feed and bedding. May be asked to provide own pen.
- 5. Entry fee is \$5.00 per head, paid in the fair office at time of arrival.
- 6. Entries close August 10. Entries should be mailed to Saline Community Fair, P O Box 423, Saline, MI 48176.
